Our Honourable Chief Guest, Sh. Satyendra Mishra, Chief Information Commissioner; Sh. S. S. Kohli Ji, Chairman, Governing Body; esteemed Members of our Governing Body; Dr (Mrs) S. I welcome you all to the 51st Annual Day Celebration of our Institute. It is indeed our privilege to have Sh. Satyendra Mishra Ji amongst us today who kindly accepted our invitation to grace us with his honourable presence. Respected Sir, I would once again like to welcome you and extend our sincere and heartfelt gratitude.

Sh. Satyendra Mishra Ji, presently Chief Information Commissioner, has previously held several top positions in the Government of India. An M.A. in English (Utkal), M. Phil. in Public Administration (Punjab) and an M Sc. in Policy Planning for Developing Countries (LSE), Sh. Satyendra Mishra Ji was inducted into the prestigious Indian Administrative Service in 1973 after a brief stint in the State Bank of India as a Probationary Officer. In his tenure he was posted as a Collector and District Magistrate in two districts for a period of about 4 years. In 1984, he moved on to work for the Madhya Pradesh State and Central Government in the Department of Culture. He next worked for more than two years both as Secretary and Director of Publications in Government of Madhya Pradesh and was involved in formulating the Information Policy of the Government and disseminating news and information for raising awareness among the people on issues like literacy, primary health care, environmental conservation and empowerment of women. Subsequently he contributed to the departments of Urban Development, Town Planning, Housing, Urban & Rural Water Supply and Infrastructure, Ministry of Personnel. He was also actively

involved in the development of small and medium enterprises, marketing and export of SME products.

Sir, your august presence shall certainly be a source of inspiration for all of us, particularly our students. With your kind permission I present a brief report of the Institute for the year 2012-13.

Institute in Retrospect

Our former Prime Minister Late Sh. Jawaharlal Nehru had said “You can tell the condition of the nation by looking at the status of women.” The status of women in India has been subject to many great changes over the past few millennia. From a largely unknown status in ancient times to the promotion of equal rights by many reformers, education of women has played a very important role in the empowerment of women and thus the overall development of our country. It has not only helped in the development of half of the human resources of our nation, but in improving the quality of life at home and outside.

Our college, the Institute of Home Economics, a constituent of the University of Delhi, founded in 1961 by Dr (Mrs) S. Malhan, has gained recognition as a premier institution involved in empowering young women by imparting quality education. Our Institute offers recently modified holistic courses which include six semester undergraduate programmes in Home Science (Pass & Hons), Microbiology (Hons) and Biochemistry (Hons); a four year integrated course in Elementary Education; a four semester post-graduate degree in Food & Nutrition and Fabric & Apparel Science; a two semester post-graduate diploma in Dietetics and Public health Nutrition; a multidisciplinary two semester Post Graduate Diploma in Health and Social Gerontology and Ph. D. programmes in all the 5 areas of Home Science.

Infrastructural Facilities

Knowledge Resource Management (KRM) plays a significant role in academics today. In its endeavour to disseminate the knowledge across a wide spectrum of students and faculty, the Institute has a fully computerised library with adequate infrastructure and a rich collection of more than 23,000 reference material in the form of text /reference books, journals, thesis, and periodicals. It subscribes to nearly 40 national and international journals in the field of Home Science. Besides, it also provides internet facility for accessing DU e-journals. The bar code system with smart cards and scanners is used for the circulation of books.

There is a modern computer lab with internet and Wi-Fi connectivity for use by the students and the faculty. An interactive website uploaded with image gallery & videos, alumni page, discussion forum etc. was launched in the golden jubilee year of the institute .The website provide to the students and others an easy access to the holistic information regarding Institute and on-going activities at the Institute.

The Institute already has well equipped laboratories. However, to accommodate the increasing number of students and the new courses, the Institute is expanding its infrastructure by constructing a new building block with state-of-the-art laboratories and lecture theatres.

To commemorate 50 yrs of excellence in the field of women education, 2011-12 our Golden Jubilee year was celebrated by conducting numerous well planned exhibitions, seminars, inter and intra collegiate competitions and national conference attended by eminent personalities including our former president Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam.

In continuation of the celebratory trend, in this session of 2012-2013,varous interesting and educative events were organized by the various departments of the institute.

Departmental Activities

We at IHE constantly believe in moving with the times. In a special initiative, the **Department of Resource Management** organized the purchase of AUTO –CAD Software designed to equip students with the latest technological knowledge for experimental design. The software was inaugurated by our former acting director, Dr. S. Passi on 27th September 2012. In addition “Oracle” the academic day celebrations of the department was celebrated by organizing various competitions such as ‘Design a Glass Panel’, ‘Design a Lighting Fixture’, ‘With only Rs. Fifty ’ and ‘Sell it’. The department is also currently conducting a 50 hr short term course in AUTO – CAD and has participants from both outside and within the college.

Our Annual **Microbiology** Festival ‘Microcosmos” organized on 12th October, 2012 saw the participation of students of the microbiology departments . Lectures were delivered by world renowned scientist Dr. Shahid Jameel, Group Leader, Virology, of the International Centre of Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology and eminent scientist Prof. T. Satyanarayana, of the Department of Microbiology, University of Delhi, South Campus. The department has also done us proud this year by producing university toppers.

To further assist our students, a special counselling centre set up in the college by the **Department of Human Development and Childhood studies**, commenced functioning this year. Additionally a series of Workshops on Reproductive Health in association with a leading NGO, Naz Foundation was organized for the entire B.Sc. (Hons) First Semester students. Students along with faculty participated in Gerry Pinto Memorial Lecture on Child’s Right to Family at India international centre. 23 students of B.Sc. Home Science 3rd year (Pass) have successfully completed 15 day internship programmes in different organizations-Dewdrops, National Association for Blind, Balsahyog,

Deepalaya, Streebal. Students of B.Sc. Home Science 3rd year (Hons) have done internships in SUNDERLAL JAIN HOSPITAL, Early intervention unit.

We as a college believe not only in imparting quality education but also in inculcating social values and a sense of social responsibility in our students, in an attempt to make them well rounded citizens. Our **Department of Elementary Education** organized sessions in concert with numerous NGO's such as Azim Premji foundation, Itihaas, Jodogyan, Butterflies, American Center, Sansarg, Reading Cell of NCERT, Narmada Bachao Andolan activist to name a few, to educate and sensitize our students. As part of the programme students also visited Bodh Shiksha Samiti as an innovation in the field of education. They also visited slums, museums, and had a heritage walk. Students also attended various public lectures, and public movie screenings and discussions organized by RRCEE, Faculty of Education, University of Delhi

The **Department of Food & Nutrition** organized a one day event sponsored by Yakult India Ltd. and Marico Industries to celebrate Nutrition Week on 4th September, 2012. Dr. Neerja Hajela, Scientific Manager, Yakult gave a talk on "Probiotics and their role" and Ms. Ritika Samadhar, Chief Dietician, Max Hospital, Saket made a presentation on "Heart Healthy Oils and Breakfast Cereals". Several competitions such as jingle composition, poster and oats cookery competitions were also organized.

Nutrition week Celebration (4th September, 2012): As part of the Departmental activity, Department of Food & Nutrition had organized one day programme to celebrate Nutrition Week on 4th September, 2012. This event was sponsored by Yakult India LTd and Marico Industries. Dr. Neerja Hajela, Scientific Manager, Yakult gave a talk on "Probiotics and their role" and Ms. Ritika Samadhar, Chief Dietician, Max Hospital, Saket made a presentation on "Heart Healthy Oils and Breakfast Cereals". Other activities organized for the students included jingle, poster and oats cookery competitions. Prizes were distributed to three best entries in each competition.

IFNAA Meet on 4th September 2012: The third meet of the IHE Food and Nutrition Department Alumni Association (IFNAA) was held on 4th September,

2012. The Meeting was attended by alumni and present students of the PG Courses of the Department as well as Ph.D scholars. Dr. S Malhan, the Patron of IFNAA released the Alumni Directory which included contact details of all alumni of the Masters Programme and Ph.D students. This was followed by an interactive session wherein five well established alumni in the field of nutrition addressed the current students of the Department and spoke about their experiences and scope of nutrition in various fields. The speakers were: Ms Anuja Agarwal (Senior Dietitian, AIIMS), Ms Kamalpreet Bhullar (Supervisor, Early Years, Modern School, Vasant Vihar), Dr Sukhneet Suri (Assistant Professor, Vivekananda College), Dr Bhavna Sharma (Nutritionist, Nestle India) and Dr Deepika Pahwa Anand (Nutrition Consultant, World Bank).

This was followed by nominations for the Executive Body of IFNAA. Dr Malhan proposed the name of Dr Santosh Jain Passi as the Patron. Dr Seema Puri was unanimously elected the President of the Association. Four other members were inducted as Executive Members.

Skill Development of Students:

- A canteen project was organised by DDPHN students where students displayed their skills in large scale food production.
- New Food Products were developed by M.Sc. students which included Herbal Tea, Aloevera ice-cream to name a few.
- A diet counselling camp was organised by the MSc Final Year students for diet counselling of elderly people.

International Day of Older Persons (8th October 2012): The students of the PG Diploma in Health and Social Gerontology volunteered at the Function organised by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and ANUGRAHA, wherein over 700 elderly persons from Delhi NCR participated. The Final Year MSc FN Students conducted a diet counselling camp at this

event and individually counselled over 100 elderly on diet management of the chronic diseases etc.

National Conference on Occupational Health (1st October 2012): The MSc FN Students in participated in a Workshop on “Effective Health Communication” and presented skits, jingles and SMSes on the theme “Healthy Nutrition at Workplace” at the National Conference on Occupational Health. They won prizes for their presentations.

A **Seminar on “Technologies in Aseptic Milk Packaging”** for both undergraduate and postgraduate students of the Department was organised in collaboration with Tetrapak and Nutritionist Republic.

Our students of the PG Diploma in Health and Social Gerontology volunteered at a Function organised by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and ANUGRAHA, wherein over 700 elderly persons from Delhi NCR participated and were counselled by our Final Year MSc Food and Nutrition on diet management of the chronic diseases.

The **Department of Communication & Extension** had an eventful year with a gamut of activities organized throughout the year. It collaborated with CRY (Child Rights and You) to launch a Child Rights Club on 16th August 2012. The A.V aids prepared by students are showcased by CRY in their various national events. The faculty and students also attended a photography workshop organized by them. The department organized a number of lectures and workshops. On 31st August 2012, Mr. Manohar Joshi, an eminent radio artist, delivered a lecture cum demonstration on voice modulation for

production of radio jingles and public service announcements. Dramabaaz Company in collaboration with the department scripted and demonstrated a puppet show on 6th September 2012 “Breaking News” in the college foyer which was highly appreciated by students and teachers alike. The aim of the puppet show was to spread awareness on the impact of Climate Change and adaptive strategies necessary to overcome climatic stresses and extremes. Mr. Binod Agarwal, an eminent communicator and former Professor of Communication, delivered a lecture on “The changing Scenario of Communication” on 11th Sept 2012. Ms. Bhanumati, an eminent puppetry trainer was invited on 22nd Sept 2012 to hold a puppet making workshop with students of Home Science Honours. The Department is collaborating with National Human Rights Commission, Government of India to organize a one day workshop in February 2013 entitled, ‘Gender Perspectives and Human rights’. This will be attended by more than 100 students and faculty members to sensitize them towards their rights. Eminent speakers from various Institutes such as JNU, IGNOU, WSDC, Breakthrough etc. will be delivering lectures and holding interactive sessions.

Our monumental growth in the field of education could not have been possible without visionaries such as our Founder Director Dr (Mrs) S.Malhan, esteemed members of our Governing Body, Former Director Dr (Mrs) Kumud Khanna, Former acting Director Dr. Santosh Passi; our highly competent teaching staff ; our dedicated non-teaching staff and our talented and hard working students. I extend my heartfelt gratitude to one and all for their contribution in making the Institute of Home Economics a premier and much sought after college for women.

Let us make our annual day an event to not only celebrate academic excellence but also let this be an opportunity to inspire each and every one of us. Let us pledge to hard work, dedication, honesty, sensitivity and empowerment of women....the true path to empowerment of the our great nation.

The **Literary and Debating Committee/Society** of the college is an active forum for students to participate in literary events throughout the year. The committee organized a Debate on August 11 on the topic “After 65 years of Independence, India is finally awake to life and ‘freedom’ ” in which students from all courses participated whole heartedly. Shruti Bhargava of Microbiology 3rd yr speaking against the motion bagged the first prize, Nancy Ninan B.El.Ed 4th yr second and Anu B.El.Ed 2nd yr secured the third prize The best interjector award went to Jigyasa of Microbiology 2nd yr. The committee also

organized an Annual General Knowledge quiz in October for all the students. The first prize was jointly shared by Nidhi Khatura and Pooja Chhikara, both of BSc Hons Biochemistry Vth semester. The committee is also working towards bringing out the Annual College Magazine “Surabhi” which gives an opportunity to our young students to showcase their literary talent and creativity

Our **Annual Sports** Meet was held on 22nd January, 2013. More than 400 students took part in Athletic events; Self-defense aerobics and various other sports related activities. Mr. Dinesh Rawat International athlete was the Chief Guest for the opening ceremony and Mrs. Reena Kaushal first Indian women to participate in expedition to Antarctica gave away the Prizes. Jyotsana Singh of B.Sc. (Hons). Biochemistry (6th Semester) was adjudged the Best Athlete and Nightingale House as the Best House for the year 2012-2013.

The **NSS Unit** of the Institute has been actively engaged in many social service related projects and programmes. This year the main focus of the NSS unit is on sensitizing society about gender equality and safety of women. Organization of blood donation camp has been a regular feature of this unit for last many years. The students associated with NSS unit are actively involved in social work with agencies like National Association for Blind (NAB) and AIIMS etc.

Besides academic excellence, the Institute also offers facilities for skill oriented add on courses in various areas as well as cultural enrichment of the students for a multifaceted personality and prepare them to face the challenges that lie ahead.

The **Short term courses** organised at the Institute include: “Identification and Inclusion of children with learning disabilities” by the Department of Elementary Education in collaboration with Orkids; “Early Childhood Care and Education” by the Department of Human Development; and “Auto-CAD and Interior Decoration by the Department of Resource Management. New paper on Extension Programme Design has been introduced for M.Sc. semester-IV Elective.

Apart from class room teaching and practical training a number of **educational field trips** were organized by the various Departments to enrich knowledge, experience and skills of the students. Department of Microbiology organized two educational trips, one for the 5th semester students along with two teachers and two non-teaching staff on 18th September, 2012 to National Dairy Research Institute (NDRI), Karnal and another to Science Health Exhibition at AIIMS on 25th September 2012, for 1st semester students, along with two teachers. Department of Fabric and Apparel Science organized the field trips to Delhi Haat, Dastkar, India Habitat Center and Crafts Museum to see various collections of textile art pieces was organized by Department of Fabric and Apparel Sciences. Field visits of the FN Department students were organised to the Defence Institute of Physiology and Applied Sciences (DIPAS), Mother Dairy (Milk Processing Unit at Patparganj), Maruti Udyog, Yakult India factory, Primary Health Centres, ICDS etc. Many such trips are also being planned for future.

The Institute has a well-qualified and experienced faculty that is actively engaged in guiding M.Sc. and Ph.D. students and conducting high quality research besides imparting high standard education to the student. The faculty members have presented and published research papers in various peer reviewed journals, authored many books and have been invited as resource persons at the international and national conferences / seminars.
