This year FERIA was called off as a mark of respect to our beloved founder Director Late Dr. Surjit Malhan whom we lost in the recent past.

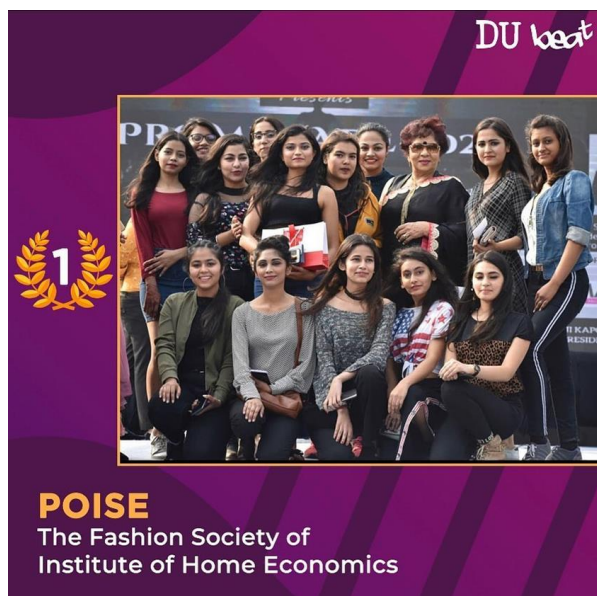
