IHE Placement Cell has undertaken various activities during 2017-2018 and 2018-2019.

Identification of two or more companies by individual departments to invite them for recruitment of the students. It was decided that all the members from the respective department would submit the list to Dr. Charu and Dr. Rajni Chopra, who further compiled the entire list submitted by all the members, which would be uploaded on the website. These companies would be further contacted. 2-5 students from each department from the IInd year (Hons.) were identified for facilitating the committee for undertaking the activities.

The form was put up on the college website to finalize the internship process further. After filling up the forms, students would submit these forms to the teacher-in-charges, which would be sent to the office later for signing by the director.

A display board was designed to put up important information and updates regarding placement and any other job/internship opportunities.

As earlier, PG departments (FAS and FN) would continue with the existing internship process in their respective departments. Every department would undertake the career counseling session in their respective departments. The time and date for the same will be intimated to the Placement cell. A brief report highlighting the session's focus will be submitted to the placement cell.
