The objectives / functions of the practice teaching are :

1. They will conduct online classes for students.
2. They will make efforts to bring offline students in the mainstream of online classes.
3. They will conduct online classes through zoom app, webex and Google meet etc. in order to make feel students as if they are learning in the class room.
4. They will help school staff in increasing enrolment and quality education.

5. They will also help in the creation & development of e-learning content, development of teaching learning material, decoration of class-rooms and walls with charts, posters, painting and drawing.
6. Students will be able at the end of session in reading, writing and solving sums pertaining to their curriculum and syllabus.

The above permission is granted subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. All the activities will be performed in the School premises in coordination with the Principal of the School and Zonal DDEs/ADEs.
2. It must be ensured that there should not be any disturbance in the School administration, discipline and routine study work of the children.
3. Institute of Home Economics, University of Delhi will have to comply with the directions of the Principal of the School.
4. Institute of Home Economics, University of Delhi will have to take care of safety and security of children in the Schools.
5. The property of the School should not be destroyed or defaced for any purpose in any manner.

10. They may provide additional teaching learning material, innovative teaching techniques, and co-curricular activities for children to ensure holistic development.
11. All pupil teachers will follow the norms enlisted in RTE Act, directions/ instructions of NCPCR and DCPCR and Education policy in vogue.
