Prof Geeta Trilok-Kumar obtained her graduation from Miranda House, University of Delhi, her Masters from the University of Guelph, Canada on a full fellowship, and PhD jointly from AIIMS and the University of Delhi in 2002. Subsequently, she went to London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine for her Post-doctoral work on a Commonwealth Fellowship. She currently holds the prestigious Wellcome Trust-DBT Senior Fellowship in Public Health, quite a rarity in the University systems.



Prof Trilok-Kumar in the last twenty years post her PhD has received several large National and International grants. She is the recipient of grants from Medical Research Council, UK; Nutrition Tier Monde, Brussels; Sight and Life, Switzerland; UGC-UKIERI thematic partnership from British Council, UK; UGC-New Zealand Research Council grant, as well as large grants from Indian funders like DBT, ICMR, to name a few. She currently has multi-crore grants from Wellcome Trust-DBT and Medical Research Council, UK as well as a large grant from DBT. Her work has been published in prestigious high impact journals like British Medical Journal and Lancet Endocrinology.

Prof Geeta Trilok-Kumar is presently the Director of Institute of Home Economics. She assumed charge of the said college in March 2018. She is not only a scientist but an excellent administrator having introduced transparency and inclusiveness and has taken her college to new heights both in teaching-learning and overall development.
