Completed forms are to be submitted in online mode only. **Upload all the specified documents mentioned below in PDF format only. Last date to submit application form is 20/08/2023 by 5.00pm.**

The eligibility criteria for admission to PGDDPHN available on the college website would be strictly followed for admission. Incomplete applications and applications without supporting documents would not be considered. Semester VI mark sheet is compulsory.

Documents to upload:

- Class 10th certificate
- Class 12th certificate
- All three-years graduation mark sheets and College provisional certificate (Should be uploaded in single PDF)
- Reserved category (OBC/SC/ST/EWS): Applicants seeking admission under these categories will have to produce certificates in their own name. **The name of the candidate, mother's name, Father's name mentioned in the application form should match with their educational certificates and category certificates.**
- OBC certificate (Central list) and EWS certificate issued on or after 31 March 2023 will be considered.
- Undertakings have to be filled and uploaded, Undertaking1 has to be filled by all, and that applying under any category is mandatory for them to fill undertaking 2 also.

Please Note: Original documents along with the print out of the duly filled form and one set of self-attested documents need to be produced for verification at the time of admission in physical mode.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

Post Graduate Diploma in Dietetics and Public Health Nutrition

All the candidates seeking admission to one year Post Graduate Diploma in Dietetics and Public Health Nutrition, PGDDPHN (2023-2024) are required to fill the form which will be available from 2nd august 2023 onwards on the college website. Closing date of application will be notified as soon as the applications are released.

The candidates must check their eligibility criteria provided below:

Candidates seeking admission to one year PG Diploma in Dietetics and Public Health Nutrition must have passed B.Sc. Home Science (Pass/ Hons.) or B.Sc. Food Technology (Hons.), B.Sc. Microbiology, B.Sc. Biochemistry, B.Sc., Nursing, MBBS, B.Sc. Life Sciences examination of the University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto and fulfil the eligibility listed below.

B.Sc. Home Science (Pass/Hons.) / B.Sc. (Hons.) Food Technology/ B.Sc. Microbiology/ B.Sc. Biochemistry/ B.Sc. Nursing / MBBS/B.Sc. Life Sciences.

55% or above marks in the overall aggregate and 50% or above marks each in any **four** of the following subjects:

1. Human Physiology
2. Nutritional Biochemistry
3. Food and Nutrition
4. Nutrition in life cycle
5. Therapeutic Nutrition
6. Public Health Nutrition
7. Food Microbiology
8. Institutional Food management

Selection of the candidates for admission to the Course will be made in order of merit, on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in B.Sc. Home Science (Pass/Hons.) or B.Sc. Food Technology (Hons.), B.Sc. Microbiology, B.Sc. Biochemistry, B.Sc., Nursing, MBBS, B.Sc. Life Sciences.

Category I: 70% and above marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./ MBBS from University of Delhi.

Category II: 70% and above marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from other Universities recognized by Delhi University as equivalent.

Category III: 60-69.9% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from University of Delhi

Category IV: 60-69.9% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from other Universities recognized by Delhi University as equivalent.

Category V: 55-59.9% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from University of Delhi.

Category VI: 55-59.9% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from other Universities recognized by Delhi University as equivalent.

NOTE: Only when a category is exhausted, will the candidates from the next category be considered. The seats will be filled in the above order of CATEGORIES only.
