### 1. ABOUT THE COLLEGE

The Institute of Home Economics (IHE) is a constituent college of the University of Delhi. Situated in the heart of South Delhi, it is a premier institute imparting education to women. Established in the year 1961 by Dr. (Mrs.) Surjit Malhan, with a two-year diploma course in Home Science, it became a part of the University of Delhi in 1969. The college celebrated its Silver Jubilee in 1986 and the foundation stone of the new building was laid in 1987 by the then President Giani Zail Singh. In 2011, the college celebrated its Golden Jubilee with a series of national workshops, seminars and an oration by former President Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam. Over the years, the Institute has grown tremendously. Beginning with just 80 students, today it has a strength of 2200 students, tutored by almost 80 faculty members and supported by about 125 non-teaching, administrative and auxiliary staff. The college offers a bouquet of courses, including seven undergraduate courses in Home Science (Pass and Hons), Microbiology, Biochemistry, Food Technology, Journalism and Elementary Education and three post-graduate programmes in the domains of Food and Nutrition, as well as Fabric and Apparel Science. The college also offers a Ph.D. programme in Home Science. Of the many achievements of the college, the most important ones during the last few years include NAAC 'A' certification, FIST Grant (2016-2021) from the Department of Science and Technology and Star College Scheme Grant from the Department of Biotechnology (2017-2022).

### 3. DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES

#### 3.1 About the departments:

##### Department of Biochemistry

Institute of Home Economics is among the six colleges of the University of Delhi to offer the esteemed course in BSc (Hons) Biochemistry. This imparts meticulous training to the students to shape them into Biochemistry professionals with conceptual clarity and updated laboratory skills. Theoretical knowledge as well as extensive hands-on practical training are provided to students in various advanced level theory and practical subjects. The program inculcates conceptualization of collaborative and multidisciplinary studies along with amalgamation and application of the basics of Biochemistry in research and technology. Analytical and problem solving skills are developed in students to cultivate competence in research and innovation. The department is also involved teaching and learning of Nutritional Biochemistry to BSc (Hons) Home Science, BSc (Pass) Home Science,

MSc Food and Nutrition and DDPHN programs in the college. Workshops, symposia, webinars, quizzes, educational trips and personality development programs are a part and parcel of departmental activities. Eminent scientists from various research institutes and industries are regularly invited to ignite the minds of budding Biochemists. The department has well equipped laboratories and competent faculty members with vast teaching and research experience.

### **Department of Microbiology**

About the department: Microbiology is a specialized and one of the most vibrant areas of biology having immense potential and applicability. It is a challenging and exciting scientific discipline that can function synergistically with allied courses like Genetics, Biochemistry, Molecular Biology, Cell Biology, Environment, Biotechnology and Bioinformatics. The Department of Microbiology at Institute of Home Economics has well equipped state-of-the-art laboratories to conduct experiments and provide hands-on-training to undergraduate students. The Department organizes workshops, seminars, webinars, hands-on-training, lecture series, educational trips and skill development programmes to enrich the teaching learning process of students and to kindle their interest in the subject. Eminent speakers and Alumni from various prestigious institutes are invited to deliver lecture on their topic of research and interact with. The Annual Academic festival “MICROCOSMOS”, organized by the department provides an opportunity to the students to interact with the scientists and academia and to showcase their creativity and talents. The students and faculty continuously strive to attain greater heights in terms of academics, talent nurturing, innovative research.

### **Department of Elementary Education**

B.El.Ed is a four-year integrated teacher education program, the first professional degree in the field of elementary education initiated by the University of Delhi in 1995 to enhance the professional knowledge and expertise of elementary teachers. It also attempts to address the professional needs and demands of elementary teaching, and thereby strengthen the elementary education of the country. The Institute of Home Economics has been offering the course since the academic year 2004-05. The B.El.Ed. Programme prepares students for a wide range of professional academic options such as teaching and research in elementary education in Government and Non-Government schools, pursuing post-graduation and subsequently qualifying to be teacher educators in State Institutes/University Departments/Colleges. Besides being eligible for a plethora of job opportunities, B.El.Ed. Graduates can also pursue Masters in various disciplines such as: Linguistics, Sociology, Social Work, Elementary Education, Psychology, Human Development, English, Mathematics, Environmental Studies or Education. The students passing out of B.El. Ed. have made their presence as professionals in the field of education.

### **Department of Fabric and Apparel Science**

The department integrates textile Science, garment design and construction, traditional textiles amongst many other aspects that governs sustainability in the textile and fashion industry. The masters program imparts rigorous practical training, internships and dissertations. Classroom teaching is supplemented with talks, field trips and workshops by experts to promote creative thinking and innovation. A Center for Sustainable Textiles - KalpTaru was established with laid objectives. The department further received a philanthropic grant from Inner Wheel Club of India to train students on upcoming aspects of “Natural Dyes”. A series of workshops were organised in the training which were well appreciated by their office bearers. Various presentations, competitions, research projects resulted from the grant. A brochure was released on the academic fest of the Department. Prof Jyoti Aggarwal designed various prototypes for the convocation gown of University of Delhi, and one of the styles were selected to be worn at the convocation. A research project on ‘Application of Microbial dyes on textile substrates’ was granted by TERI to Prof Charu Gupta. An Msc student- Ishani Subuddhi did a paid internship with ‘Blockbuster inc’ on ‘design development inspired byGond tribes’ and the designs were selected for industrial production. The faculty continuously strive to excel in academics and innovative research, in particular with PG students.

## **Department of Sciences**

The Department of Sciences of the college comprises Biology (Botany, Environmental Science, Zoology) Chemistry, and Physics departments; which play an important role in the fundamental development of interdisciplinary courses such as Home Science, Microbiology, and Biochemistry. The Department's primary goal is to plant the seed of knowledge in the minds of young people so that they can excel in the field of modern science. The Department is devoted to discovering fundamental knowledge of the living world and emphasizes multidimensional approaches to studying science across various scales.

## **Department of Human Development and Childhood Studies**

Department of Human Development and Childhood Studies includes committed faculty whose professional and academic pursuits include guiding doctoral students, conducting research, and contributing to academic writing and publication. The faculty members also share their expertise and skills through community outreach and intervention activities. Such activities encourage students to learn new skills and sensitize them to diversity. The department is committed to preparing professionals who can successfully engage with multiple contemporary concerns and the changing global challenges through academics, research, and community action. We have always been conscious of extending the teaching-learning process beyond the classroom by providing our students varied opportunities to experience and discover the real world. Student seminars, workshops by eminent resource persons and field trips to relevant organizations are an innate part of our department practice.

Aarambh is the Early Childhood Learning Centre initiated and nurtured under the guidance of the Department of Human Development and Childhood Studies, focuses on early learning by providing a range of child stimulation activities guided through physical-motor, cognitive- language and social-emotional domains of development, along with a Day Care Centre. VOICES - The Mental Health Society is a student society initiated by and under the aegis of the Department.

## **Department of Development Communication, Extension and Journalism**

In the contemporary times, communication has the power to touch and transform lives of people by empowering them. The Department offers specialization in Development Communication and Extension to Home Science students. It also offers a BA (hons) program in Journalism. The students receive training both in the theoretical as well as the practical aspects of Communication through modern ICTs as well as traditional media. The students ideate, script and produce communication materials such as radio programs, short films, documentaries, participatory videos, digital stories, photo features, power point presentations, newsletters and audio-visual shows. Along with this, print as well as traditional media such as educational floor and board games, grassroots comics, posters, info-graphics, advertisements, flip charts, flash cards, bulletin board, street play and puppetry are also designed and developed. The Department has a state-of-the-art audio studio for training students in radio production.

Besides media production, field visits, interaction with community members at the grass-root level, interface with the industry, seminars, workshops and lectures by experts, inter-college and intra-college competitions are an integral part of the course. Every year the Department organizes annual academic event COMSCAPE focusing on various issues ranging from contemporary social, economic and technological concerns of society. Besides this, the department trains the students in fulfilling their social responsibilities by reaching out to the community through a community out-reach literacy, digital literacy and skill training program. Each One Enable One The Department organizes short-term certificate courses from time to time for the benefit of students such as in Radio Jockeying Campus to Corporate Photography The Art of Storytelling Traditional media and Use of Software for Print Media. The Department also facilitates internship opportunities for desirous students in NGOs, media houses, radio channels and Development organizations. The faculty of the Department is highly experienced and is involved in research and outreach activities in addition to teaching. The faculty members

have published several research papers in various national and international journals and have authored many books on communication and allied fields. Students are also registered for Ph.D. program under the guidance of expert faculty of the Department. The Department started offering BA(Hons) in Journalism since the academic year 2017-18.

### **Department of Food & Nutrition and Food Technology**

The Department of Food and Nutrition & Food Technology (FNFT) organized several activities for the students, faculty, and the community at large to enrich them about the important aspects of food, nutrition, and lifestyle in the academic year 2022 – 2023. The department offers two PG programs, M.Sc. (Food & Nutrition) and one year Post Graduate Diploma in Dietetics and Public Health Nutrition (PGDDPHN). The courses within these programs have been carefully designed to improve students' core competencies in the areas of public health nutrition, dietetics, and food science. To widen the horizon of the students, the department holds seminars, workshops and lectures delivered by eminent people working in the related fields. The students and faculty are encouraged to participate and present papers at various National and International conferences.

#### **5.4. Automation and Website committee**

The committee undertook several tasks during this period. A Faculty Development Program (FDP) in collaboration with the Teaching Learning Center at Ramanujan college, DU was organized by the committee on the topic, 'Academic Research Writing' from July 8-14, 2023. It was a huge success and received very positive feedback. The FDP attended by more than 220 participants from across institutions of which more than 50 were from IHE. The committee undertook updation of the website encompassing faculty profile updation as several new faculty had joined August to November 2023. The cultural and academic events were also updated. Further the identity cards of all the semester 1 students across all UG and PG courses were made and distributed to the students through the committee members. Another major job undertaken by the committee is the addition of RAM in 37 computers in the computer lab to enable faster speed of computers and usage of software requiring more space. Since the contract of Educational Management software provider to the college had expired in September 2023, a call for tenders was prepared by the committee members and uploaded on the CPP portal. The companies which had submitted their proposals were called for presentation to enable the final selection process which is likely to be completed soon.

#### **5.5.NSSCommittee**

Indian social service programme, the National Service Scheme builds character through community service. Since 1969, the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports runs it. The NSS motto is "Not Me, But You," which emphasizes selflessness and putting others first. It promotes social improvement and individual responsibility. The NSS encourages youth to serve their communities and the nation. The NSS IHE unit has successfully promoted social awareness and instilled a sense of responsibility for their communities among college students. Through various initiatives and programmes, the NSS unit has also provided students with opportunities to develop leadership skills and collaborate toward common goals of social responsibility and integration. A

Initiatives like “Har Ghar Tiranga” and the Independence Day Parade were filled with messages of patriotism as an honor for India’s freedom fighters. This year, the NSS unit participated in a series of initiatives and events held under the GoI campaign ‘Meri Mati Mera Desh’ and also represented the college at Kartvya Path, where the Honorable PM addressed NSS volunteers and a pledge ceremony for nation-building took place.

The volunteers marked the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan by actively carrying out a cleanliness drive at the banks of the Yamuna River in addition to a cleaning campaign held in the college and neighbouring bus and metro stations.

### **5.7. Student amenities committee**

  - c. Tender document for the Canteen has been prepared and shall be uploaded as soon as the elections are over.
  - d. Microbial testing of canteen food/preparations (mint chutney, coconut chutney, samosas) for potent pathogenic microbes has been done. Food was found suitable for consumption.
3. **Girls Common Room**
- a. 1 Desert cooler have been placed in the GCR.
  - b. Decorative materials and Educational material were displayed to enhance the aesthetic appeal of the room.
4. **Photocopy:**
- a. New photocopy vendor has been given the tender for the college premises.
  - b. The committee regularly monitored the quality of photocopy and printouts in the photocopy shop.

### 5.8. Vidya Vistar Scheme

The Vidya Vistar Scheme was launched by University of Delhi to further the vision of the NEP, 2020. The scheme proposes setting up of collaborative academic and capacity building efforts between the colleges/departments of University of Delhi and institutions of higher education located in remote areas of the country. The idea is to create a well-connected and supportive environment for higher education by maximizing the resources available at each institution.

#### Objectives of Vidya Vistar Scheme

To collaborate with other institutions for:

- Expertise, knowledge and experience of the faculty members
- Resources in the library
- Other academic facilities

As a part of this important effort, the Institute of Home Economics has signed a MoU of collaboration with Government Zirtiri Residential Science College, Aizwal Mizoram in 2022.

Activities under VVS July 2023-March 2024

The following activities were undertaken by IHE in collaboration with the Government Zirtiri College, Aizwal:

1. Dept. of Biochemistry, IHE organised a talk on Pre-Diabetes for the staff and students of Zirtiri college and IHE under the Vidya Vistar Scheme on 09.02.2024. The presenters were Prof. Archana Burman, Dr. Savita Bansal and Dr. Meenakshi Vaccher. The online webinar was attended by around 80 people. Participants also received certificates at the end of the webinar.
2. A talk on Battling Cancer held at IHE by INSA, IHE and UGC-MMTTC on 13.02.2024 was attended online by faculty and students of Zirtiri College, Aizwal.
3. Dept of Elementary Education and Dept of English organised an online student interaction programme for students of both colleges on 21 March 2024. The theme of the session was Fostering Speaking and Writing Skills in English (Using cultural contexts). Faculty from IHE, Dr Suneeta Mishra and Ms Anita George and faculty from Zirtiri College, Dr Kimi Hamte, Dr Msi Chhangte, Dr. Masangi were the session facilitators. The session will be followed up with a letter writing activity to encourage communication and interaction between the students of the two colleges.
4. A Workshop on Computational Drug Discovery was conducted from April 15th to 16th, 2024, organized by the Department of Microbiology under the Vidya Vistar Scheme. The title of the workshop was “Practical Perspective on Molecular Dynamics Simulation.”, conducted by Dr. Manish.

### क . यूनिकोड एवं नवीनतम टूल्स प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम

16 जनवरी 2024 को संघ सरकार की राजभाषा नीति के अंतर्गत यूनिकोड एवं नवीनतम टूल्स प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किया गया। इस प्रशिक्षण के लाभार्थी संस्थान के गैर-शिक्षण कर्मचारी रहे। प्रशिक्षण में श्री आनंद कुमार सोनी, उप कुलपति इंदिरा गांधी राष्ट्रीय मुक्त विश्वविद्यालय को बतौर विशेषज्ञ बुलाया गया। श्री आनंद कुमार सोनी जी को प्रशासनिक, वित्त एवं राजभाषा के क्षेत्र में लगभग 21 वर्षों का अनुभव है। उन्होंने राजभाषा की परिभाषा देते हुए कहा कि शासकीय परियोजनाओं के लिए प्रयोग की जाने वाली भाषा को राजभाषा कहते हैं। विशेषज्ञ ने गैर-शिक्षण कर्मचारियों को राजभाषा का अनुपालन क्यों करना चाहिए इसके निर्देश दिए। हिंदी में काम करना हमारी संवैधानिक जिम्मेदारी है। उन्होंने अनुच्छेद 343, 347 और 351 के बारे में अवगत कराया एवं धारा 3(3) का अनुपालन शत प्रतिशत अनिवार्य रूप से किया जाए, इस ओर ध्यान आकर्षित किया। उन्होंने राजभाषा के 12 नियम बताए जिसमें से नियम 2, 5, 6, 10, 11 एवं 12 पर विस्तार से चर्चा करते हुए इनके अनुपालन की जरूरत से अवगत कराया। इसके साथ उन्होंने यूनिकोड के बारे में भी बताया। यूनिकोड की मदद से कोई भी किसी भी फाइल को हिंदी में नाम दे सकता है। उन्होंने की-बोर्ड ले आउट का प्रदर्शन कर उसके बारे में बताया। इसके साथ ही रेमिंगटन, गोदरेज, देवनागरी जैसे की-बोर्ड से भी अवगत करवाया।

### ख . 'अंतरराष्ट्रीय मातृभाषा दिवस'
