

SOP of Scientific Research Committee

1. Scope- The Scientific Research Committee aims to instill and augment a research culture among students and faculty via planning supporting activities to meet the objectives laid by the National Education Policy. The committee would encourage collaborations across industry, government, community-based organizations and agencies at the local, national and international levels.
2. Composition – The Committee comprises of 9 faculty members
3. In a series of meetings and discussions, the committee has formulated guidelines for operationalizing research projects. This would enable a smoother utilization of resources and better liaison of the Principal Investigator with other stakeholders. It would give more autonomy to the Investigators within the laid-out rules. The committee is also in the process of formulating the guidelines for reimbursement to faculty for presenting papers at conferences/ attending capacity-building workshops/ funding small research projects leading to publications. This will strengthen the “project” component of the IPAC as is instituted in the UGCF of NEP. This financial support would boost the way to research-based activities. The guidelines are yet to be passed by the staff council of the college.
4. The Committee has also planned a conference for UG/ PG students wherein they present research in the form of papers or posters. The modalities of the conference will be worked out. The conference is planned for the year 2024. The theme of the conference would encompass the domain of all the departments of the college. An official email – Src24@ihe.du.ac.in has been made for this purpose.
5. All the members of the committee would make an effort to apply for funding for organizing conferences. These could be in bodies like – ICSSR, CSIR, UNICEF, DST, UNDP etc
6. The committee would further organise workshops, trainings or talks for capacity building in the college
