Major activities conducted by the Department of Food and Nutrition & Food Technology (FNFT)

Workshops/Seminars/ lectures organized

1. WORKSHOP ON VEDIC NUTRITION

Department of Food & Nutrition and Food Technology in collaboration with Dr. Shikha Sharma's One Health Initiative organized a workshop on "Introduction to Vedic Nutrition" on 21st March'2023, Tuesday from 11 to 1 PM in the conference hall of the college. 2. Academic visits and seminars/workshop attended by the students

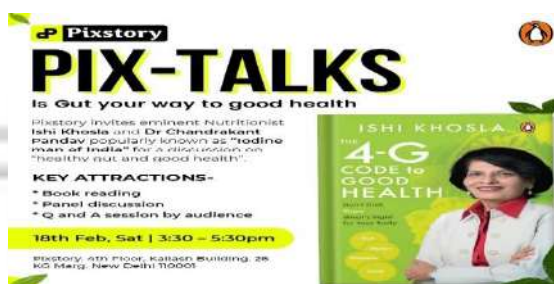
