REINVENTION SIX YARDS 2025

Rule and guidelines for the competition

Theme: Participants must adhere to the theme of "Reinventing the Six Yards" and ensure their design reflects creativity, innovation, and relevance.

Categories: Specify if the reinvention includes draping, styling, sustainable redesign, or creating new products using sarees.

Rules for Participation:

- 1. Each participant can present only one entry.
- 2.Group participation is allowed (if applicable); however, a maximum of [2/3] students per group is permitted.
- 3. The use of pre-existing or commercial designs are not
 - allowed.
- 4. Teams have to bring their own props if required.
- 5. The judges' decision will be final.
- 6.Participants will have a time limit of [2-3 minutes] to explain their design concept and drape or showcase their creation.

Judging Criteria:

- 1. Creativity and Innovation
- 2. Aesthetic Appeal
- 3. Practicality
- 4. Presentation
