<u>GENERAL GUIDELINES</u> <u>Semester – I Batch (Academic 2025-2026)</u>

Dear Students,

We welcome you at IHE. We are delighted to have you as part of our vibrant, inclusive and diverse academic community.

You are expected to take note of the following as you navigate your journey at IHE:

- 1. **Orientation Program:** An orientation program will be organised for you. This session will introduce you to the faculty, departments, academic structure, and the different student societies of the college. (The date will be announced soon. Kindly keep checking the website for the notification. Attendance for the orientation program is *mandatory*).
- 2. Class Commencement, timetables and syllabi: Regular classes will begin from 1st August, 2025. Please check the respective department notice board and the college website to familiarize yourself with the timetable. You can find your course syllabus on the college website. A HELP DESK will be set up by the Orientation Committee for you at the college foyer on 1st August 2025. Reach out to the faculty and student volunteers for any kind of assistance.
- 3. **Attendance:** Make sure you attend your classes regularly and on time. The College follows the guidelines of attendance and internal assessment of the University very strictly. Your attendance is part of the internal assessment. Students falling short of stipulated attendance shall not be allowed to sit for the end semester exams. - 4. **Anti-Ragging Policy:** IHE follows a strict **anti-ragging policy** as per UGC guidelines. Any form of ragging is considered a punishable offense. If you experience any untoward incident, report to the **Anti-Ragging Committee**, faculty, or college authorities. Anonymous complaints can also be made. All students must fill the anti-ragging undertaking online at www.antiragging.in
- 5. **ID Cards:** College ID Cards shall be issued to you soon. You are expected to carry your college ID at all times. It is also required for entering the campus and using library facilities. Till the ID cards are issued, your fee-receipt can be used for entry.
- 6. **Communication Channel:** You will soon be getting your official e-mail IDs. Stay updated through the official notice board, college website, and student WhatsApp/Telegram groups. Always use your registered email for any communication with college.

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- 7. **College Library**: IHE has a well-equipped college library with a comfortable reading space. Reach out to the library staff to use the **Delhi University e-resources portal** for free access to books and journals.
- 8. **Student Societies:** At IHE academic learning is complemented by a wide range of extra-curricular activities. We encourage you to be a part of the different student societies as per your interest. These societies will not only enrich your campus experience but also help you grow socially, creatively, and professionally. - 9. **Grievance Redressal:** College follows varied mechanisms of grievance redressal. We have a student grievance redressal committee, Internal Complaints Committee, North East Committee, Equal Opportunity Cell (EOC) for the welfare of SC/ST/OBC/Minority students, Enabling Unit (EU) for students with disability and disciplinary committees. - 10. **Counseling cell and Mentorship:** IHE provides academic and emotional support through its counseling cell. The college has also a very systematic advisory system. Each of you will be assigned a Faculty Advisor to whom you can always reach out for support. Regular meetings will be held with your advisors. Kindly attend these meetings diligently.
- 11. **Safety Mechanisms:** The campus is guarded. Be familiar about the entry/exit rules. There is medical room on campus for basic medical facility for emergencies. Save contact numbers of key college authorities and Delhi Police helpline (100 or 112).
