Post Graduate Diploma in Dietetics and Public Health Nutrition
PGDDPHN ADMISSION (2025-26)

This is to inform all that admission to the Post-Graduate Diploma in Dietetics & Public Health Nutrition (PGDDPHN) for the academic session 2025-26 is still open. Interested and eligible candidates are invited to complete the admission formalities.

Admission Form for Post Graduate Diploma in Dietetics and Public Health Nutrition (PGDDPHN) is available for the admission. Students are requested to fill the Google form (<https://forms.gle/1Y7vhwYEk3bJhAQf7>).

The candidates must check their eligibility criteria provided below:

Candidates seeking admission to one year PG Diploma in Dietetics and Public Health Nutrition must have passed B.Sc. Home Science (Pass/ Hons.) or B.Sc. Food Technology (Hons.), B.Sc. Microbiology, B.Sc. Biochemistry, B.Sc. Life Sciences, B.Sc., Nursing, MBBS, examination from the University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent to University of Delhi and fulfil the eligibility listed below.

55% or above marks in the overall aggregate and 50% or above marks each in any **four** of the following subjects:

1. Human Physiology
2. Nutritional Biochemistry
3. Food and Nutrition
4. Nutrition in life cycle
5. Therapeutic Nutrition
6. Public Health Nutrition
7. Food Microbiology
8. Institutional Food management

Selection of the candidates for admission to the Course will be made in order of merit, on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in B.Sc. Home Science (Pass/Hons.) or B.Sc. Food Technology (Hons.), B.Sc. Microbiology, B.Sc. Biochemistry, B.Sc., Nursing, MBBS, B.Sc. Life Sciences.

Category I: 70% and above marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./ MBBS from University of Delhi.

Category II: 70% and above marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from other Universities recognized by Delhi University as equivalent.

Category III: 60-69.9% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from University of Delhi

Category IV: 60-69.9% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from other Universities recognized by Delhi University as equivalent.

Category V: 55-59.9% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from

University of Delhi.

Category VI: 55-59.9% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade point of B.Sc./MBBS from other Universities recognized by Delhi University as equivalent.

NOTE: Candidates from the next category will be considered once the seats in category I are fully occupied. The seats will be filled according to the specified order of Categories only.

The total seats and distribution is given below:

NOTE:

- It is mandatory that candidates, who apply for this course, must have cleared their B.Sc./MBBS and result has been declared
- Candidates must have their **VI semester** mark sheet.
- The candidate must fill the form completely with correct information.
- All supporting documents mentioned in the Google form should be **scanned (<10 MB)** and uploaded in **PDF only**.
- Incomplete forms not supported by all the documents would not be considered.

The eligibility criteria for admission to PGDDPHN is also available on the college website (<https://ihe.du.ac.in/admission/postgraduate-admissions/eligibility-criteria/>) would be strictly followed for admission.

Documents required for the admission:

- Class 10th certificate
- Class 12th certificate
- All three-years graduation mark sheets and College provisional certificate (Should be uploaded in single PDF)
- Reserved category (OBC/SC/ST/EWS): Applicants seeking admission under these categories will have to produce certificates in their own name. **The name of the candidate, mother's name, Father's name mentioned in the application form should match with their educational certificates and category certificates.**
- OBC certificate (Central list) and EWS certificate issued after 31 March 2025 will be considered.

Please Note: Original documents along with a set of self-attested documents need to be produced for verification at the time of admission in physical mode.
