PROCEDURE FOR RE-REGISTRATION FOR DSC/DSE/GE/AEC COURSE

Students must contact the teacher presently teaching the course(s) and Reregister and attend the Course(s)/Paper(s). The concerned teacher is required to maintain and upload the attendance and assessment records of all such students.

To 'Re-register' for a course/paper means to formally inform the college authority by a student of his/her intent to improve a course/paper. Students will submit application with latest marksheet and a very nominal fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged for re-registration.

PROCEDURE FOR RE-REGISTRATION FOR SEC/VAC COURSE

- ❖ Students must contact the teacher who had taught the paper in the semester when he/she enrolled initially and Reregister and attend the Course (s)/Paper(s).
- ❖ In case, the concerned teacher is no longer part of the college or on leave during the current semester, the student must approach the Teacher-in-charge of the concerned department which had initially offered the course. The department in such cases is required to make provision for re-registering and assessing the student.
- ❖ The concerned teacher is required to maintain and upload the attendance and assessment records of all such students.

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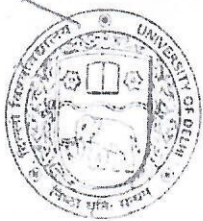

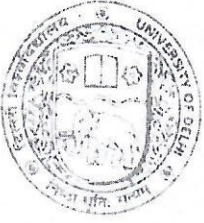
1. To enable students to improve their grades under PGCF-2025, the following may be adopted:

2. (i) A student who has passed in a course/paper in an earlier semester, but wishes to improve the marks of both the theory (written exam marks) and Internal Assessment (IA) but excluding the attendance component of the IA, may be allowed to carry forward their previous attendance marks of IA and improve upon the rest of the two components i.e. Class Test and Assignment by re-registering for the course/paper and learning through self-study mode.

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- (ii) To 'Re-register' for a course/paper means to formally inform the Department/College authority by a student of his/her intent to improve a course/paper. The Department/College may create a proforma/Google Form to seek such information from the students and may charge a very nominal fee (maximum Rs. 100/-) to systematize the process.
3. To overcome the issue of overlapping of the classes of the current semester and that of the class timings of the course of an earlier semester which a student wishes to improve the marks cumulatively, the following are proposed as per the deliberations:
- (a) Holding of classes of such students from 6 to 8 pm OR on Saturdays or Sundays or both the days.
 - (b) Faculty members of the Department/College who take classes for these students at the timing or days mentioned in point 3(a) may be paid honorarium as per norms of the University if they take such classes over and above their prescribed workload in the Department/College. However, a faculty member may be permitted to teach a maximum of four credits in a semester for such students.
